2 NIGHTS IN ATHENS

DAY 1: ARRIVE ATHENS, GREECE, EVENING TOUR WITH GREEK DINNER SHOW

At **Athens airport** you'll be met and transferred to your hotel.

Start your vacation with a group **evening excursion of Athens** (group, 3.5 hours @8pm). Enjoy spectacular views of top Athen's attractions such as the Parthenon, Temple of Zeus and Greek Parliament building, all beautifully floodlit against the night sky. Then walk through the narrow picturesque streets of Plaka to a typical taverna for a traditional Greek dinner with live music and Greek Folk Dance in traditional costumes.

Note: Your flight must arrive by 3 pm to enjoy this evening excursion on Day 1, otherwise partake this evening excursion on Day 2.

DAY 2: THE ACROPOLIS, ATHENS WALKING CITY TOUR AND ACROPOLIS MUSEUM

Visit the key famous attractions of ancient and modern Athens on this comprehensive half-day group tour, admission tickets are included (group, 5.5 hours @9:30am).

Experience ancient Greece's greatest monument: the **Acropolis**. Explore the new **Acropolis Museum** with a guide to explain and put everything in context for you. You'll see the Changing of the Guards outside the **Greek Parliament**, stroll the **National Garden**, and admire historic monuments including the **Parthenon**.

2 NIGHTS IN MYKONOS

DAY 3: ATHENS – MYKONOS BY FLIGHT

Check-out and travel by air to **Mykonos** (included). Upon arrival transfer to the hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is free.

DAY 4: MYKONOS - MYKONOS TOUR

After breakfast, join your guided **Mykonos tour** (group, 3.5 hours @10am).

Discover the best that Mykonos has to offer during this combination walking and driving tour. Drive to several island hotspots like **Kalafatis Beach** and the charming village of **Ano Mera**. Take a walking tour to explore the white-washed buildings of Mykonos town and see beautiful landmarks including the iconic **windmills** and the **Paraportiani church**.

2 NIGHTS IN NAXOS

DAY 5: MYKONOS – NAXOS

Check-out and proceed to the port to board the high-speed ferry for **NAXOS**. Arrive and check-in to your hotel. The rest of the day is free.

Naxos is the largest of the Cyclades islands in the Aegean sea. It offers Cyclades' largest, beaches, ancient ruins, quaint mountain villages, Venetian architecture, and a historic hilltop castle.

DAY 6: NAXOS HISTORY AND CULTURE GUIDED TOUR

Today's activity is **Naxos History and Culture Guided tour** (group, 4 hours @8:30am)

We will get a comprehensive overview of Naxos' landmarks. Explore **Demeter's Temple** and the village of **Chalki**. See the famous **Kouros Statue** and **Flerio Valley**. Sample locally-made olive products at an **olive museum**.

3 NIGHTS IN SANTORINI

DAY 7: NAXOS - SANTORINI BY FERRY

Hotel check-out and travel by ferry to **Santorini** which is arguably the best-known and most breathtaking of all of the Greek islands. Upon arrival, transfer to the hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is free.

Believed by some to be the lost continent of Atlantis, this historic and unimaginably picturesque island is situated on the edge of a submerged volcano. Stand high on the cliffs to admire the incredible views of white Cycladic houses with blue painted windows that have inspired artists over the ages. During your free time, sample the distinguished local wines and sunbathe on one of its many beautiful beaches which are home to transparent azure waters, with black, red or white sand depending on which beach you visit.

DAY 8: SANTORINI CALDERA CRUISE TOUR

Combine a visit to Santorini's caldera, volcano and hot springs with this cruise (group, 6 hours @9:30am). Start at **Nea Kameni**, where you'll have time to walk around this volcanic island and swim in its hot springs. Cruise on to **Thirasia island** and its typical Cycladic village, where you'll have enough time to have lunch (on your own) and explore before sailing back to Santorini. Tiny houses of various colors give a special character to these small settlements.

DAY 9: SANTORINI

Breakfast at the hotel. Free Day.

DAY 10: DEPART GREECE – END OF TOUR

After breakfast, check-out and transfer to **Santorini airport** for your flight to Athens (not included) and then the flight home.
