3 NIGHTS IN FRANKFURT

DAY 1: ARRIVE FRANKFURT

Arrive at **Frankfurt Airport (FRA)**. Your driver will meet you at the airport for a transfer to your hotel. The remainder of the day is free.

Frankfurt is a vibrant financial and cultural center featuring modern skyscrapers that contrast with the historic buildings in the old town. You can taste local specialties such as Frankfurter sausages, Grüne Soße (green sauce), Handkäse mit Musik (cheese with onions and vinegar) and Apfelwein (apple wine).

DAY 2: FRANKFURT WALKING TOUR

This morning, we join the **Frankfurt Walking Tour** (group, 3 hours).

Enjoy a leisurely walking tour led by a local expert who brings Frankfurt's rich history to life through engaging storytelling. This tour offers a perfect blend of iconic landmarks and hidden gems, providing ample opportunities for stunning photos.

Frankfurt Cathedral (Kaiserdom): The majestic Imperial church and historic site of the elections and coronations of the Holy Roman Emperors.

The Römerberg: Explore the iconic City Hall, the Fountain of Justice, and the moving Memorial to the Nazi Book Burning.

Old St. Nicholas Church (Alte Nikolaikirche): One of the city's oldest and most charming medieval churches.

Karmeliterkloster: A former monastery housing impressive, historic wall paintings.

Eiserner Steg (Iron Bridge): Often called the "Love-lock Bridge," offering the best panoramic views of the skyline across the Main River.

Kleinmarkthalle: A vibrant indoor market featuring everything from artisan chocolates to fresh local produce.

Jewish Heritage: A visit to the Old Jewish Cemetery and the site of the medieval Jewish Ghetto.

Staufenmauer: A rare look at the original city defensive walls dating back to the 1100s.

Stadtplanungsamt: A unique stop to view a massive, detailed scale model of present-day Frankfurt.

Cultural Landmarks: See the exterior of the **Goethe House** (birthplace of the famous writer) and the grand **Old Opera House**.

Note: On Sundays, church interiors and the Kleinmarkthalle are viewed from the exterior only. The Stadtplanungsamt (City Planning Department) is closed on weekends.

DAY 3: CHRISTMASTIME EVENING WALKING TOUR OF THE NEW OLD TOWN

This evening, we join the **Christmastime Evening Walking Tour of the New Old Town Frankfurt** (group, 2 hours).

Frankfurt Christmas Market: Centered around one of Germany's tallest Christmas trees and the chimes of the city's massive church bells.

Experience the magic of the holidays in Frankfurt's New Old Town. As you take in the scents of the Christmas market, your guide will share the history of the city's newest district, featuring a blend of 15 historic replicas and 20 modern structures. This tour perfectly pairs festive traditions with Frankfurt's architectural crown jewels: the Cathedral, the Römer, and St. Paul's Church.

1 NIGHT IN NUREMBERG

DAY 4: FRANKFURT – NUREMBERG | OLD TOWN AND CHRISTMAS MARKET

Transfer from the hotel to **Frankfurt** train station and take the train to **Nuremberg** (standard class), then transfer to the hotel.

This afternoon we explore **the Old Town and Christmas Market** (group, 2 hours).

Nuremberg offers a uniquely medieval atmosphere, world-renowned for its strict "Original" traditions—from its iconic gingerbread and tiny bratwursts to the ceremonial appearance of the golden Christkind. Experience the enchanting winter magic of Nuremberg's world-famous Christmas Market on an intimate, guided journey through the heart of the festivities. As you wander through a landscape of twinkling lights and festive melodies, you'll do more than just see the market—you'll feel the soul of the holiday season.

Featured Landmarks: Hauptmarkt Nürnberg, Old City Hall, St. Sebaldus Church, Tiergärtnerplatz, Albrecht Dürer's House, and the picturesque Weissgerbergasse.

2 NIGHTS IN MUNICH

DAY 5: NUREMBERG – MUNICH, THIRD REICH & WWII TOUR

Take the highspeed train from **Nuremberg** to **Munich**. Hotel and train station transfers are included.

This afternoon, join the **Third Reich & WWII walking tour** (group, 2 hours in the afternoon).

Uncover the dark side of Munich's history. Learn how the Bavarian capital served as an important center for the Nazi Party during WWII and hear stories of Hitler's rallies and The White Rose resistance movement. Along the way, visit key sites like Königsplatz, Feldherrnhalle, the Hofgarten and the famous Hofbräuhaus beer hall.

Munich is rich in history, with landmarks like Marienplatz. Marienplatz (Mary's Square) is a central square in the heart of Munich, named after the Mariensäule (Marian column).

Munich showcases stunning Gothic to Baroque architecture. It offers a blend of modernity and tradition, with bustling markets, chic boutiques, and lively cafés. This city is well known for traditional Bavarian food and beer.

DAY 6: NEUSCHWANSTEIN & CHRISTMAS MARKET

Join the **Neuschwanstein Castle & Christmas Market Guided Tour (group, 9 hours)** today. Discover the beauty of the **Bavarian Alps** countryside, and visit the iconic **Neuschwanstein castle**. The **Marienbrücke**, a historic pedestrian bridge that offers the most iconic, postcard-perfect view of **Neuschwanstein Castle** as it spans the Pöllat Gorge high above the waterfall. Learn about King Ludwig II and his architectural masterpieces, and enjoy the stunning views and expert commentary along the way.

Next, we'll immerse ourselves in the **Munich Christmas Market**, uncovering the cherished Bavarian traditions and "hidden gem" landmarks that define the city's festive soul. Along the way, you'll savor authentic seasonal delicacies that make Munich's holiday culinary scene truly legendary.

DAY 7: DEPART MUNICH

After breakfast, transfer to **Munich Airport (MUC)** for your flight home to the USA or Canada.
