DAY 1: HANOI

Welcome to Vietnam! Your driver will meet you at the airport for a transfer to your hotel. The remainder of the day is free.

Hanoi is one of the most ancient capitals in the world where travelers can find well-preserved colonial buildings, ancient pagodas, and unique museums within the city center. This French-colonial city is known for its delectable cuisine, vibrant



nightlife, silks, and handicrafts, as well as a multi-cultural community with Chinese, French and Russian influences.

DAY 2: HANOI | CITY TOUR (B)

Today begins with a blast from the past. See Vietnam's traditional ways of life and replicas of old homes. Visit **Ba Dinh Square** and the **Ho Chi Minh Mausoleum** honoring the revolutionary guerrilla leader who pursued independence for Vietnam.

We then visit the lotus-shaped **One Pillar Pagoda** which dates back to the first Vietnamese empire that was independent from China, **Tran Quoc Pagoda** and Hanoi's first university namely the **Temple of Literature**. Followed by **Ethnology Museum**, **Hoan Kiem Lake** and the ancient **Old Quarter**.

DAY 3: HANOI - HA LONG BAY (B, L, D)

Depart for your overnight cruise on **Ha Long Bay**, often called Vietnam's eighth wonder of the world. Ha Long means Descending Dragon. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Explore the bay with excursions like kayaking, swimming, and fishing. Settle onto your deck chair and witness spectacular sunsets. Join in a cooking demonstration featuring traditional Vietnamese cuisine, followed by a gourmet dinner on board. Retire to your cabin to enjoy a restful night's sleep as the waves lap gently against the hull.

DAY 4: HA LONG BAY - HANOI (B, L)

Greet the day with a sunrise Tai Chi lesson overlooking the bay. Breakfast on the boat followed by an excursion to the most beautiful and biggest cave in the bay or to a floating village that was voted as one of the 11 insanely beautiful small towns around the world by Huffingtonpost.com. After Ha Long Bay, visit one of the nearby villages to experience the life of a northern farmer. Return to Hanoi.

DAY 5: HANOI | END OF TOUR (B)

After breakfast the tour ends. Hotel check-out and transfer to **Noi Bai International Airport (HAN)** for your flight home.
